2017 REWA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Rewa Vineyard always seems to produce fruit with a distinctive freshness iderived from its soils of intermixed volcanic tuff and river-worn cobble. This minerality lifts Rewa's intensely aromatic and richly flavored wines and magnfies their fruit characteristics.

The 2017 vintage of Rewa Cabernet Sauvignon was hand harvested prior to dawn on October 2. It displays aromas of raspberry jam, blackberries, brambleberry, cocoa, cedar, anise and mint tea. On entry, the wine is ripe and expansive on the palate and this continues all the way through to the finish. It is dense and highly concentrated with a finish of fresh, juicy fruit notes. The tannins are approachable and present.

This wine was crafted entirely from the Rewa Estate in Coombsville, Napa Valley. The fruit was harvested by block and fermented separately, pressed, transferred to French oak barrels, and kept as discreet lots for approximately ten months. The wine was then blended and returned to barrels for an additional year of aging in French oak. The wine was bottled without fining or filtration on July 18, 2019.
